A stand-alone TNW determination is conducted for a specific segment of river or stream or other type of waterbody, such as a lake, where independent upstream or downstream limits or lake borders are established. A stand-alone TNW determination should be completed following applicable guidance and should NOT be documented on the AJD form.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> Because of the broad nature of the (b)(1) exclusion and in an effort to collect data on specific types of waters that would be covered by the (b)(1) exclusion, four sub-categories of (b)(1) exclusions were administratively created for the purposes of the AJD Form. These four sub-categories are not new exclusions, but are simply administrative distinctions and remain (b)(1) exclusions as defined by the NWPR.

# C. Additional comments to support AJD:

The area in review contains 12.25 acres and includes three excluded waters. Wetlands A-C are completely encompassed by uplands and lack a direct or indirect surface connection to (a)(1)-(3) waters. Wetlands B & C continue offsite to the south where they are physically separated from the nearest (a)(1)-(3) water by a road (Maybank Highway). Since, Wetlands A-C do not abut an (a)(1)-(3) water, are not inundated by an (a)(1)-(3) water and are physically separated by more than a single artificial barrier, they are determined to be non-jurisdictional.
