These four sub-categories are not new exclusions, but are simply administrative distinctions and remain (b)(1) exclusions as defined by the NWPR.

The ditch receives stormwater run-off from Fox Run Apartments (northwest of pond) via a culvert and directs the flow to NJP-1 (discuss below). On this basis, NJF-1 does not meet the criteria of a jurisdictional feature as identified in paragraph (c)(12), and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(5).
NJF-2 (b)(5) Excluded Water	17 feet	(b)(5) Ditch that is not an (a)(1) or (a)(2) water, and those portions of a ditch constructed in an (a)(4) water that do not satisfy the conditions of (c)(1)	NJF-2 is man-made ditch constructed in upland soils (soil map: Goldsboro Loamy Sand), it is not constructed on nor is a rerouted (a)(1)-(a)(4) water. The ditch receives stormwater run-off from NJP-1 outfall (discuss below). On this basis, NJF-2 does not meet the criteria of a jurisdictional feature as identified in paragraph (c)(12), and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(5).
NJP-1 (b)(8) Excluded Water	0.49 acres	(b)(8) Artificial lake/pond constructed or excavated in upland or a non-jurisdictional water, so long as the artificial lake or pond is not an impoundment of a jurisdictional water that meets (c)(6)	NJP-1 is a man-made pond constructed in upland soils (soil map: Goldsboro Loamy Sand). NJP-1 was is not an impoundment of a jurisdictional water that meets paragraph (c)(6), it receives stormwater flow from Fox Run Apartments (northwest of pond). NJP-1 was permitted as a stormwater detention feature by SCDHEC under permit number 28-00-08-02, dated September 8, 2000. On this basis, NJP-1 does not meet the criteria of a jurisdictional feature as identified in paragraph (c)(6), and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(8).
