This is in response to your request for an Approved Jurisdictional Determination (AJD) (SAC-2004-35583) received in our office on March 16, 2022, for a 16.464-acre site located at 1820 Harmon Street, Charleston County, South Carolina (Latitude: 32.8294°, Longitude: -79.9483°). An AJD is used to indicate the Corps has identified the presence or absence of wetlands and/or other aquatic resources on a site, including their accurate location(s) and boundaries, as well as their jurisdictional status pursuant to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (CWA) (33 U.S.C. § 1344) and/or navigable waters of the United States pursuant to Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 (RHA) (33 U.S.C. § 403).

The site is shown on the attached survey plat entitled "WETLAND SURVEY OF TMS#464-02-00051/PREPARED FOR/ CITY OF CHARLESTON DEPARTMENT OF PARKS/ LOCATED IN THE CITY OF NORTH CHARLESTON / CHARLESTON COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA" and dated April 2022 and last revised April 25, 2022 prepared by Joseph L. Mcintyre, P.L.S. S.C. REG. # 15513 and was submitted by Newkirk Environmental, Inc. Based on an on-site inspection, a review of aerial photography, topographic maps, National Wetlands Inventory maps, and soil survey information, and Wetland Determination Data Forms, we conclude the site, as shown on the referenced plat, does not contain any aquatic resources subject to regulatory jurisdiction under Section 404 of the CWA or Section 10 of the RHA.

Attached is a Memorandum for Record describing the basis of jurisdiction for the delineated area(s). Note that some or all of these areas may be regulated by other state or local government entities and you should contact the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control, Bureau of Water, Bureau of Land and Waste, or Department of Ocean and Coastal Resource Management, to determine the limits of their jurisdiction.

This AJD is valid for five (5) years from the date of this letter unless new information warrants revision before the expiration date. This AJD is an appealable action under the Corps of Engineers administrative appeal procedures defined at 33 CFR Part 331. The

administrative appeal options, process and appeals request form is attached for your convenience and use.

This AJD was conducted pursuant to Corps of Engineers' regulatory authority to identify the limits of Corps of Engineers' jurisdiction for the particular site identified in this request. This AJD may not be valid for the wetland conservation provisions of the Food Security Act of 1985. If you or your tenant are USDA program participants, or anticipate participation in USDA programs, you should request a certified wetland determination from the local office of the Natural Resources Conservation Service, prior to starting work.
