⁵ Because of the broad nature of the (b)(1) exclusion and in an effort to collect data on specific types of waters that would be covered by the (b)(1) exclusion, four sub-categories of (b)(1) exclusions were administratively created for the purposes of the AJD Form. These four sub-categories are not new exclusions, but are simply administrative distinctions and remain (b)(1) exclusions as defined by the NWPR.

Wetland	0.417 acre	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	This wetland is a closed polygon boundary that is not contiguous or directly abutting an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water. In addition, this wetland does not meet any of the other (a)(4) criteria for adjacency and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(1). Ditch 1, which is a (b)(5) water as discussed below, comes out of the wetland and continues to McCaulley Creek. According to the Navigable Waters Protection Rule, a ditch cannot render an otherwise isolated wetland an "adjacent wetland" and thus jurisdictional on that basis, unless the ditch itself is a tributary.
Ditch 1	0.1	(b)(5) Ditch that is not an (a)(1) or (a)(2) water, and those portions of a ditch constructed in an (a)(4) water that do not satisfy the conditions of (c)(1)	Ditch 1 appears to have been excavated from uplands and a portion of the Wetland. However, the ditch is not an (a)(2) water. Ditch 1 comes out of the wetland and continues to McCaulley Creek.
