Within the review is an excluded water (b)(5) ditch that was determined to be excavated entirely from uplands and does not meet the criteria of a jurisdictional water. The feature is neither naturally occurring, a diversion of a tributary, nor constructed within the boundaries of an adjacent wetland. Flow if any within the feature appears to be directly in response to precipitation.

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
