These four sub-categories are not new exclusions, but are simply administrative distinctions and remain (b)(1) exclusions as defined by the NWPR.

Ditch 1	478 feet	(b)(5) Ditch that is not an (a)(1) or (a)(2) water, and those portions of a ditch constructed in an (a)(4) water that do not satisfy the conditions of (c)(1)	The ditch segment on this parcel represents 478 feet of ditch excavated within uplands and that does not meet criteria as any category of water. The ditch does carry flow, but only in response to precipitation.
