Pursuant to Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 (33 U.S.C. 403), Section 401 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1344), and the South Carolina Coastal Zone Management Act (48-39-10 et.seq.), an application has been submitted to the Department of the Army and the S.C. Department of Health and Environmental Control by

for a permit to modify an existing boat docking facility in waters of

Lucy Point Creek

at a location adjacent to Sam's Point Road (SC Highway 802) next to the existing bridge on Coosaw Island, Beaufort County, South Carolina (Latitude 32.484132°. Longitude -80.599442°)

The proposed project consists of adding deck space, a boat float, a catwalk, a boat lift and roofing to the existing boat docking facility. In detail, the proposed work consists of adding a 12' x 24' fixed deck, a 12' x 7' plastic boat float, and a 3' x 24' catwalk leading to a covered 13' x 13' boat lift to the existing boat docking facility. The work also includes the addition of an 8' x 42' roof over an existing walkway for protection from the elements. According to the applicant, the additional deck is for activities associated with operation of the facility, the boat float is for mooring of a rescue boat, and the boat lift is for a pontoon boat that will be used in operations of the facility. The proposed work will be reviewed as a Section 10 project only for the additional structures proposed in tidal waters and as such, the applicant has not proposed to mitigate for impacts to wetlands and/or waters of the United States. The project purpose is for space to conduct dock operations, for additional tie-up space for a rescue boat and for a pontoon boat to enhance dock operations.
