U.S. Army Corps Of Engineers Announces Public Comment Period for the Former Conway Bombing and Gunnery Range Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis

May 9, 2002

CHARLESTON, S.C. --- Officials at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers announces the public comment period for the former Conway Bombing and Gunnery Range Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis.

The Conway Bombing and Gunnery Range, located in Horry County, was used to train air-to-ground gunnery and bombing troops during World War II.

The Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) presents the findings of a site investigation and recommendations for future activities.

The public comment period will end on July 11, 2002. The Corps will hold a public meeting in July to discuss the EE/CA report.
