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Second Temporary Closing of Arrowhead Boat Ramp

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CHARLESTON, S.C.--- The Arrowhead Boat Ramp will be closed to the public on April 16 due to high water conditions, according to officials at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Charleston District.

Recent excess rain and high flows in the Santee River have created unsafe conditions for launching and retrieving vessels at the boat ramp. The boat ramp will remain closed until Corps officials deem conditions safe for use.

The boat ramp is located off Highway 45 on Arrowhead Road next to the Cooper River Rediversion Project.

This is the second closing of the ramp time this year. Arrowhead Boat Ramp closed March 25 to April 7 due to the high water and unsafe conditions at the ramp site.
