Stein selected for Charleston District's top civilian position

CHARLESTON, S.C.--- William Stein became the top ranking civilian employee for the Charleston District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers with his selection as the Deputy District Engineer for Programs and Project Management. He is responsible for managing the district's Planning, Programs, and Project Management Division.

In his new position, Stein is responsible for managing a 150-person work force. The district is made up of engineers, scientists, technicians and administrators, jointly working together to accomplish flood control, navigation, water resources planning, design, construction and operations in the State of South Carolina.

Prior to this position, Stein served as the Acting Chief of the Business Management Division for the South Atlantic Division, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. He has worked for the Corps for 29 years in several different capacities.

A native of New Jersey, Stein earned his bachelor's degree in civil engineering in 1974 from Bucknell University in Lewisburg, Pa. He holds a Professional Engineer license in Georgia.
