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Corps completes dredging of Steel Mill Channel in Georgetown

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CHARLESTON, S.C.--- The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), Charleston District recently completed maintenance dredging of Steel Mill Channel in Georgetown Harbor.

Southern Dredging, of Johns Island, S.C., dredged the federally maintained channel as part of a \$1.7 million contract to dredge the Georgetown Harbor area. More than 100,000 yard of material was removed from Steel Mill channel.

The purpose of the project was to dredge the channel to its federally authorized depth of 27 feet, which allows for safer and more efficient movement of vessels that use the federal channel.
