

Thank you for your letter of September 18, which we received on September 22, 1998.

While it would be erroneous to say that the Area of Potential Effect for the Daniel Island Terminal Expansion has been 100% surveyed, there has been extensive cultural resources identification over the past few years. You referenced many of these surveys in your September 18 letter. We think that you can use the information from these previous surveys to develop a resource base.

We would not recommend another architectural survey for the Area of Potential Effect at this point. Please be aware that when the specific area of direct impact has been identified, you may need to conduct a more extensive architectural survey of that direct impact area.
