for a permit to perform excavation in waters of

LAKE MURRAY

at three locations in the Night Harbor Marina, 824 Yacht Club Pt. in the Town of Chapin, Lexington County, South Carolina (Latitude 34.10853°, Longitude 81.36943°)

The proposed work consists of performing excavation at three areas within the existing Night Harbor Marina while the water level of Lake Murray is drawn down to the 345' elevation. The amount of material to be excavated is 1375 cubic yards from three locations that total 0.407 acres in area. The purpose of the project is to allow the 20 boat slips to be used year round.

NOTE: This project was originally advertised on 18 April 2003, but omitted the fact that the project will also require review under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1344). Please make this correction.
