Pursuant to Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 (33 U.S.C. 403), Section 401 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1341), the S.C. Construction in Navigable Waters Permit Program (R. 19-450, et seq., 1976 S.C. Code of Laws, as amended) and the South Carolina Coastal Zone Management Act (48-39-10 et seq.), an application has been submitted to the Department of the Army and the State of South Carolina by

for a permit to perform maintenance excavation in waters of

LAKE MOULTRIE

at a location at the mouth of the cove on the west end of the Hatchery off of S-8-802 five miles north of the town of Moncks Corner in Berkeley County, South Carolina (Latitude 33.26773°, Longitude 80.10462°)

Please note: This project was advertised on October 10, 2003, however there was an error in the public notice that included processing under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1341). In addition, the project will require processing under the South Carolina Coastal Zone Management Act (48-39-10 et seq.). Please make these changes.

The proposed work consists of performing maintenance excavation to remove 13,222 cubic yards of material from the mouth of the cove on the west end of the Hatchery in an area measuring 300' x 170' x 7' (1.17 acres). The work will be done using a marine based barge and track hoe. The spoil material will be placed on high ground as shown on sheet 4 of 4 and stabilized. The purpose of the project is to return the mouth of the cove to its original depth to allow the use of the existing boat ramp and for ingress and egress to Lake Moultrie.
