for a permit to perform excavation in waters of

LAKE WYLIE

at a location adjacent to 1029 Bounty Lane in Tega Cay, York County, South Carolina (Latitude 35.02676°, Longitude 81.02020°)

The proposed work consists of performing excavation to remove 133 cubic yards of silt material from an area measuring 30' x 40' x 3' at the end of an existing dock in waters of Lake Wylie. The work will be performed using a barge and long reach excavator. The material will be placed into dump trucks and hauled to a disposal site owned by the agent for the applicant at 628 Oakridge Farm Highway, Mooresville, NC. The purpose of the project is for private boating access to Lake Wylie. **Please note:** This public notice was sent out in error. The proposed work is already authorized by General Permit No. 2002-14-004 issued to Duke Power and Lake Front Property Owners.
