Identify and evaluate alternatives and the preparation of a decision document that, as appropriate, recommends a coordinated and implementable solution for flood risk management **in the City of Charleston, South Carolina.**

STATUS

As of March 2024 – Feasibility Cost Sharing Agreement signed March 5, 2024. The City of Charleston and Charleston District are working together to define the scope, schedule, and budget for the study. In FY24, the FY24 Appropriations Bill funded the study \$600,000 from Congressional Directed Spending. The study was not funded in the FY25 President's Budget.
