Location Description:	Edisto Island is a barrier island approximately 4.5 miles in length and located approximately 45 miles southwest of Charleston, South Carolina.		
Project Description:	There are significant problems affecting buildings and infrastructure on Edisto Beach. Homes and businesses are perilously close to structural failure as a result of erosion caused by coastal storms, particularly hurricanes and northeasters. State Highway 174 is the only evacuation route off the island and has been subject to overwash and flooding. If allowed to continue unabated, erosion will continue to threaten other infrastructure such as water and electrical systems. With these problems, there are opportunities to reduce risks to buildings and infrastructure from storms, protect the islands only emergency evacuation route, and to preserve long-term sea turtle nesting and shorebird habitat. The Chief's Report was signed on September 5, 2014.
