**Location** The project is on the coast of South Carolina, in Georgetown County, about 13 miles southwest of the City of Myrtle Beach, SC.

**Project** The project maintains 0.6 miles of entrance channel, 3 miles of inner channel, one turning basin, one deposition basin, and two stone jetties. In 2017, non-federal funding and a contributed funds agreement were used to place dredged sand from the channel on portions of Garden City beach.

**Status** As of 7 November 2022 - The District received \$6.1M from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law of 2021 and \$500k is identified in the FY23 President's Budget to dredge Murrells Inlet Federal Channel. Sand dredged from the federal channel will be placed both on Garden City Beach for coastal storm damage reduction and Huntington Beach State Park to protect the Murrells Inlet south jetty structure.
