CLOUTER CREEK DISPOSAL AREA

- Approximately 1400 acres subdivided into four "cells."
 - ▶ Northern third is owned by the South Carolina State Ports Authority (SCSPA).
 - ▶ Southern two-thirds of the area (formerly owned by the U.S. Navy) are now owned by the Corps of Engineers,
- The Federal Government holds a perpetual easement on the state-owned portion.

- Dike Raising in Middle Cell (Sept 16 – Aug 17)
- Dike Failure Fix in Highway Cell (Sept 16 – Mar 17)
- Ditching Commence in South Cell (Summer 17)
