Stormwater pond	3.51 acres	(b)(10) Stormwater control feature constructed or excavated in upland or in a non-jurisdictional water to convey, treat, infiltrate, or store stormwater runoff	This feature was excavated entirely in uplands based on the verification of a previous JD (SAC-81-97-0003) which called the area uplands. Based on a review of Aerial imagery, the stormwater pond was constructed between 1994 and 2005 for the sole purpose of stormwater management in conjunction with the surrounding development. It should be noted that the entirety of the stormwater pond was not included in the review areas for this JD.
