The area did not satisfy all three wetland factors (hydrology, hydric soils, hydrophytic vegetation) in normal circumstances for a typical year. Additionally, the location of the pond does not lie below the ordinary high water mark or the high tide line of a jurisdictional water. Therefore, this office has determined this pond to be situated in uplands and therefore an excluded non-jurisdictional water.
