However, the wetlands are a closed polygon and the southern side of the wetlands are approximately over half a mile from the nearest down gradient tributary (Halfway Gut Creek). The wetlands are not contiguous or directly abutting an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water. Furthermore, the wetlands do not meet any other of the (a)(4) criteria for adjacency and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(1).
