Non-jurisdictional wetland 2	0.5 acres	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	Onsite Wetland 2 is part of a closed polygon wetland that extends offsite. Additionally, based on a review of the offsite resource information, the off-site portion of the wetland t is not contiguous or directly abutting an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water. In addition, this wetland does not meet any of the other (a)(4) criteria for adjacency and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(1).
