- C. Additional comments to support AJD: The 5.1 acre review area includes one jurisdictional water and a single excluded water as indicated in Section II A. The feature identified on the plat as "0.262 ACRES BELOW OCRM CRITICAL LINE" is subject to the ebb and flow of the tide and therefore meets the criteria of an (a)(1) water. The feature identified on the plat as 'EXCLUDED WATER (DITCH 1) extends 164 feet along a portion of the northwest parcel boundary. Ditch 1 is an Excluded Water under (b)(5) as a ditch that does not meet criteria for (a)(1) or (a)(2) waters, and also does not meet criteria for (a)(4) waters that satisfy the conditions at (c)(1). These features are shown on the plat entitled "CRITICAL LINE EXHIBIT COOPER FOLLY ROAD TRACT CITY OF CHARLESTON CHARLESTON COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA" and dated August 7, 2020

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
