B. Typical year assessment(s): Antecedent Precipitation Tool (APT) results for typical year determination were calculated based on field collection date (December 8, 2020) of the USACE site visit. Output from the APT indicated "Wetter than Normal" with a condition value of 18 during a period of "moderate wetness" in the Wet Season.
