- **B.** Typical year assessment(s): Antecedent Precipitation Tool (APT) data for the typical year assessment was calculated based on the field collection date denoted on the wetland determination data forms (November 2, 2020). Output from the APT indicated "normal" conditions at the time of data collection by the agent (Sabine and Waters, In.) with a condition value of 14. For this assessment, a total 10 weather stations within a 14-mile radius were used.
- **C.** Additional comments to support AJD: This review covers a 0.89 acre site that is currently developed with no open water features, features that exhibit characteristics of a tributary, or areas that meet the three parameters of a wetland located within the project area. The site consists entirely of uplands.

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
