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C. Additional comments to support AJD: The 5.05-acres wetlands (Excluded Water 1 and Excluded Water 2) on this parcel are a single closed boundary polygon. Note that while only 5.05 acres of the wetlands are located on the subject parcel, the wetlands extend into an adjacent parcel on the southwest portion of the site (TMS 138-00-00-002). The entire wetland is a closed boundary, and does not abut any (a)(1)-(a)(3) water. The wetlands are not inundated by flooding by an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water, or separated from any (a)(1)-(a)(3) water by any natural or manmade barrier. As such, the subject wetlands do not meet any of the criteria for an (a)(4) adjacent wetland, and thus has been determined to be an excluded waters under (b)(1).

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
