C. Additional comments to support AJD: The project site is comprised of 52.88 acres of which, 20.25 acres are determined to be excluded (b)(1) waters (EW 1-6). The excluded wetlands do not abut and are not inundated by an (a)(1)-(3) water. Additionally, these wetlands are physically separated from any (a)(1)-(3) waters by multiple physical, man-made barriers (residential lots, roads, etc.) and uplands. The excluded waters are surrounded by uplands (review of NWI, Topographic Maps, aerial, and soils maps) and lack a direct or indirect surface connection to (a)(1)-(3) waters. Additionally, the USGS TNM-National Hydrology Dataset, depicts no flow of the wetlands outside the man-made barriers to include subdivisions, and public access roads that surround the entire wetland system. Additionally, Lidar 3DEP Hillshade and Horry DEM with Elevations denotes no discernable or traceable outfall of wetlands located within the review area to an (a)(1)-(3) waters. Previous JDs determined the onsite wetlands to be isolated and not adjacent to any waters of the US. The wetlands are located approximately 0.7 mile from an (a) (1) water and 0.6 mile from an identified (a) (2) water. A site visit was performed for this Jurisdictional Determination. Site visits were preformed for the previous two (2) JDs documented under SAC-2008-00048-3IT and SAC-2008-01855-3H.
