B. Typical year assessment(s): Antecedent Rainfall Calculator data for typical year determination was calculated based on the field collection date provided by the agent (28 OCT 2020). The Antecedent Rainfall Calculator data showed "normal" conditions at the time of data collection by the agent with a

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condition value of 12, which indicates that typical year hydrologic conditions were present. For this assessment, nine weather stations, located within a 18-mile radius, were used.

C. Additional comments to support AJD: This 0.1-acre site contains no jurisdictional water or excluded waters. Although the site is mapped Bladen, a hydric soil, and is depicted as wetlands on the topographic map, the aerials depict the site as a developed residential lot with no waters present within the project boundary. The NWIs depict this site as comprised primarily of uplands with palustrine forested wetlands located on the northwestern corner and the southwestern corner. The information submitted by the agent, including photographs of the property, indicate that this 0.1-acre site consists of uplands.

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
