Excluded Wetland B	7.443 acres	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	Wetland B is partially located adjacent to what appears to be an offsite excavated lake/pond. Based on a review of offsite information, it appears that Wetland B continues offsite to the south west towards Red Dam Road. However, it does not appear that the wetland continues to the south/south west of Red Dam Road. Also it does not appear that culverts are present at this location beneath Red Dam Road that would potentially maintain a hydrologic connection to any wetland that may be located offsite to the south of Red Dam Road Additionally, uplands surround the portion of Wetland B that is located onsite. Therefore, wetland B is that is not contiguous or directly abutting an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water. In addition, this wetland does not meet any of the other (a)(4) criteria for adjacency and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(1).

Excluded Wetland D	0.294 acre	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	Wetland D appears to continue offsite to the south west and abuts I-95. The portion of Wetland D located onsite is surrounded by uplands. Based on a review of offsite information, it appears that Wetland D, including the offsite portion, is a closed polygon boundary that is not contiguous or directly abutting an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water. In addition, this wetland does not meet any of the other (a)(4) criteria for adjacency and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(1).
Excluded Wetland E-1	3.981 acres	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	Wetland E-1 appears to continue to the north to an existing powerline easement. The portion of Wetland E-1 located onsite is surrounded by uplands. Based on a review of offsite information, it appears that Wetland E-1, including the offsite portion, is a closed boundary that is not contiguous or directly abutting an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water. In addition, this wetland does not meet any of the other (a)(4) criteria for adjacency and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(1).
Excluded Wetland E-2	0.004 acre	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	Wetland E-2 is a closed polygon boundary that is not contiguous or directly abutting an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water. In addition, this wetland does not meet any of the other (a)(4) criteria for adjacency and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(1).

In addition, this wetland does not meet any of the other (a)(4) criteria for adjacency and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(1).
Excluded Wetland H	0.643 acre	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	Wetland H is a closed polygon boundary that is not contiguous or directly abutting an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water. In addition, this wetland does not meet any of the other (a)(4) criteria for adjacency and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(1).
Excluded Wetland A-2	0.593 acre	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	Wetland A-2 appears to continue offsite to the south and is adjacent to an offsite excavated lake/pond. Based on a review of offsite information, it appears that that Wetland A-2, including the offsite portion, is a closed polygon boundary that is not contiguous or directly abutting an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water. In addition, this wetland does not meet any of the other (a)(4) criteria for adjacency and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(1).
Excluded Wetland A-1	0.004 acre	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	Wetland A-1 appears to continue offsite to the south and is adjacent to an offsite excavated lake/pond. Wetland A-1 onsite is surrounded by uplands. Based on a review of offsite information, it appears that that Wetland A-1, including the offsite portion, is a closed polygon boundary that is not contiguous or directly abutting an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water. In addition, this wetland does not meet any of the other (a)(4) criteria for adjacency and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(1).
