These four sub-categories are not new exclusions, but are simply administrative distinctions and remain (b)(1) exclusions as defined by the NWPR.

Furthermore, the wetland does not meet any other of the (a)(4) criteria for adjacency and thus is an excluded water pursuant to (b)(1).
Stormwater Pond	1.53 acres	(b)(10) Stormwater control feature constructed or excavated in upland or in a non-jurisdictional water to convey, treat, infiltrate, or store stormwater runoff	The pond was constructed to manage stormwater under the NPDES program and is not an (a)(1-4) water.
