- B. Typical year assessment(s): N/A.
- C. Additional comments to support AJD: Excluded Wetland continues off-site to the south emptying into a (b)(5) man-made ditch excavated from upland which then enters a (b)(10) stormwater control pond excavated from uplands. According to the Navigable Waters Protection Rule, a ditch cannot

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render an otherwise isolated wetland an "adjacent wetland" and thus jurisdictional on that basis, unless the ditch itself is a tributary. The ditch does not meet the conditions of an (a)(1) or (a)(2) water (i.e. it is a TNW or a tributary). Therefore, Excluded Wetland is determined to be a non-jurisdictional (b)(1) excluded water and not subject to regulation under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.

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
