- **B.** Typical year assessment(s): Antecedent Rainfall Calculator data for typical year determination was calculated based on the field collection date provided by the agent (4 Feb 2020). The Antecedent Rainfall Calculator data showed "wetter than normal" conditions at the time of data collection by the agent with a condition value of 18, which indicates that typical year hydrologic conditions may not be present. For this assessment, one weather station, located within a 13-mile radius, was used. Even though site conditions for the date of the data forms do not represent typical year hydrologic conditions and flow regimes, the status for the excluded water remains unchanged.
- C. Additional comments to support AJD: The 3.5-acre project site includes one excluded water. NJW-A was determined to be an excluded water (non-jurisdictional) in a previous AJD issued on 18 April 2015 (SAC-2015-00618). Based on a review of the aerials, topographic map, soil survey, NWIs, and information submitted by the agent, the excluded wetland was determined to be a closed boundary polygon with no connections to (a)(1) (a)(3) waters.

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
