B. REQUIRED ADDITIONAL COMMENTS TO SUPPORT JD. EXPLAIN RATIONALE FOR DETERMINATION THAT THE REVIEW AREA ONLY INCLUDES DRY LAND: The NWI map shows the possible presence of a forested wetland, the Richland County LiDAR shows some possible features, however there are no other indicators from the topo, or soils maps. Furthermore, upon a Corps site investigation, no jurisdictional features were observed. The project area consists entirely of dry lands.
