C. Additional comments to support AJD: Excluded Water Wetland Area 3 continues off-site to the southeast emptying into a man made ditch. According to an AJD (SAC-2007-00342-1T) dated March 21, 2013, the aforementioned ditch is referenced as a "Utility/Drainage Easement", excavated from uplands, not exhibiting an ordinary high water mark and possessed no evidence of relatively permanent flow. According to the Navigable Waters Protection Rule, a ditch cannot render an otherwise isolated wetland an "adjacent wetland" and thus jurisdictional on that basis, unless the ditch itself is a tributary. Therefore, Excluded Water Wetland Area 3 is determined to be a non-jurisdictional (b)(1) excluded water and not subject to regulation under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.

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
