Revised method for disposal of the dredged material

April 9, 2013

The public notice issued for this project on May 18, 2011, included disposal of the dredged material at the Citadel Disposal Site, Drum Island Disposal Site, or the SCDNR Disposal Site. None of these locations proved suitable for the disposal of the dredged material. Therefore, the applicant is now proposing to use an on-site dewatering system involving mixing the sediment slurry with a polymer, moving the thickened sediment through a belt press and discharging the clarified water back to the Ashley River via a pipeline. The inflow and outflow pipelines will be routed along the Tradd Street Pier and along upland areas to the dewatering equipment. The dewatering equipment will be set up on an existing asphalt area at the Coast Guard Station as shown on the attached map. The dewatered dredged material will be temporarily stockpiled on site until it is loaded in trucks for disposal. The material will be covered to prevent any runoff during rain events, and silt fencing will be installed around the area to prevent sediment runoff. Disposal of the material will be at either a DHEC certified landfill (either a C&D landfill or a RCRA Subtitle D landfill) or at an existing confined upland dredge material disposal site.

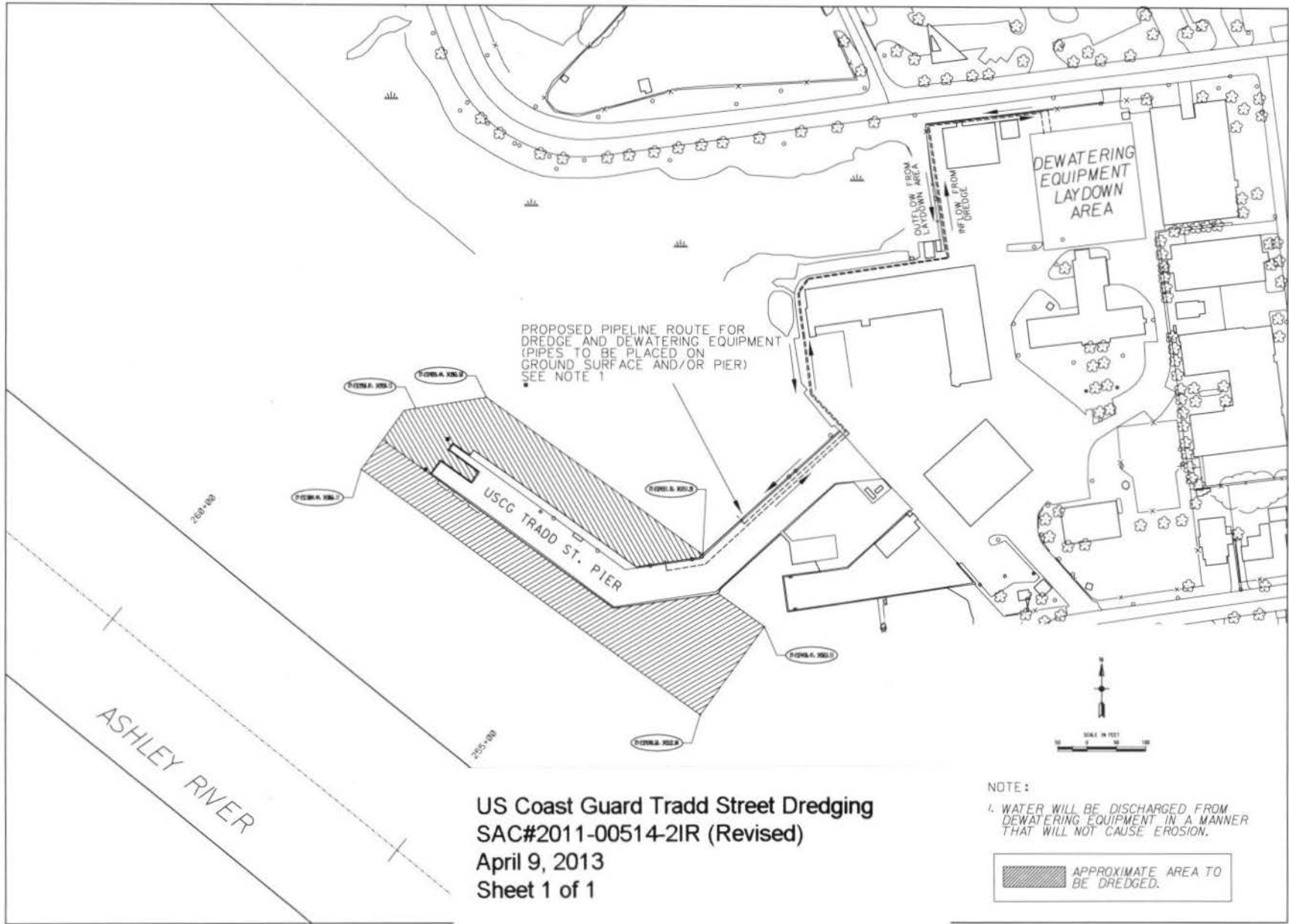
